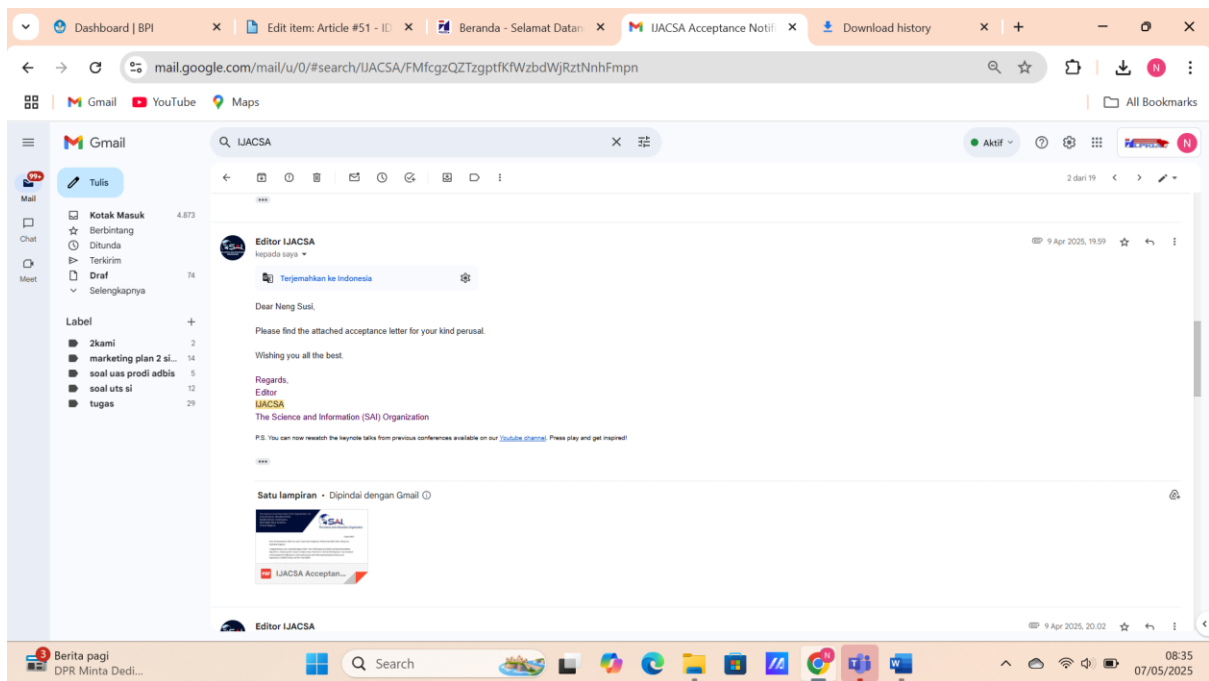

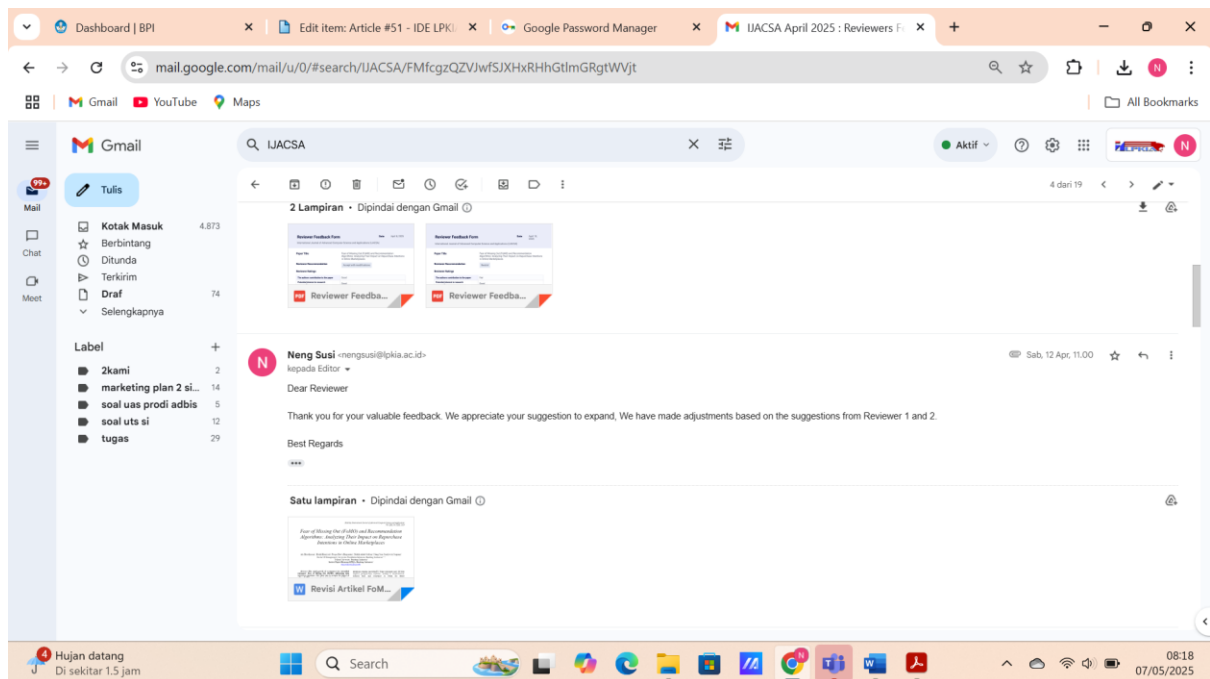

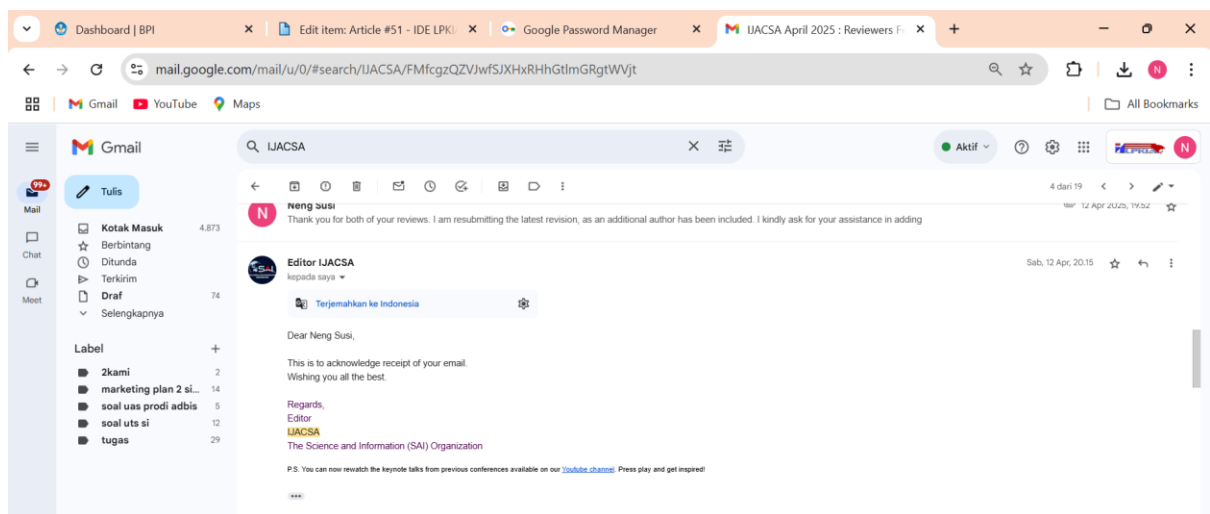
#### Detailed Comments:

- Please add comparisons in a table (or subsection) so that one could fairly compare your work with similar previous works.
- Table number should be mentioned in the text:  
"The inclusion and exclusion criteria for participant selection are outlined in the following table" - Table I  
"The following table presents the path analysis results" - Table II
